## WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

$\$ 25,000$ prize money will be distributed between the top 8 teams. Female, male and mixed teams will play in the same division.

The Teqvoly World Championship will be held on 6-8 September. We provide practise opportunity for each team on 6 September.

A team has to pay $€ 50$ registration fee and has to travel to Budapest. Transportation to the hotel, accomodation, food and beverage and a city tour is on our company.

6 September - practise, opening ceremony with the draw
7 September - group stage and single elimination
8 September - semi-finals and finals

## MAIN RULES OF TEQVOLY

- Teqvoly is played by two teams of two players
- A match is won by winning one or more sets depending on the competition format
- A set consists of two winning games
- A game is won when a team reaches 8 points
- There is a hexagon shaped line system consisting of baselines and sidelines, which plays an important role in ruling the actions that take place on the court
- Doublepoint: a chance to score two points instead of one (per set)
- The server has two chances to execute a successful service
- The serve must bounce only once on the opponent's playing surface of the table
- Each team has a maximum of 3 touches, a minimum of 1 pass is required and passes need to alternate between players on the same team
- When returning the ball, it must bounce only once on the opposite side of the table
- Returning the ball is only allowed if the ball is on your own team's side
